

## Coronavirus Covid-19 Boatyard Arrangements

To comply with Government instructions, we detail below the arrangements made at the boatyard to limit the spread of Coronavirus Covid-19.

- 2 metre social distancing to be observed. Please be mindful of other boat owners and members of the boatyard crew. The main gates to the boatyard will remain closed to limit the number of vehicles in the yard to give more space for social distancing.
- Liquid soap and hot water is available in the toilets for hand washing. We will check the soap dispenses on a regular basis but please let us know if stocks run low.
- The boatyard crew will only attend the boatyard for boat movements and maintenance. However, we will be working from home when not at the boatyard so please feel free to contact us [enquiry@quaylaneboatyard.co.uk](mailto:enquiry@quaylaneboatyard.co.uk) We will also check phone messages and get back to you as soon as possible.
- With the exception of residential berth holders, Government instructions do not allow for overnight stays on board.
- Boat owners are welcome to instruct one contractor to work on their boat and meet with the contractor at the boatyard in case of need.
