### **Boatyard Arrangements**

Dear Boat Owners

Following the Prime Minister's announcement on 4<sup>th</sup> January 2021, the boatyard will remain closed to the public. We will comply with Government instructions and review the position after 15<sup>th</sup> February.

Boat movements will continue to be undertaken by the boatyard crew. The boatyard will not normally be manned when there are no boat movements unless essential maintenance is required.

Access to the pontoons by berth holders is permitted for essential maintenance. No overnight stays on board are allowed with the exception of residential berth holders where their boat is their primary residence. Please lock car park and pontoon access gates after use.

For safety reasons, inspections of the boatyard and pontoons will be carried out by a limited number of staff, adhering to social distancing and personal hygiene guidelines.
