Moorings at Peewit Island and Bomb Ketch are in deep water but vessels may ground on certain low tides during the year. Quay Lane moorings are semi tidal. Please see our web site for the location of the mooring areas. Tenders can be stored free of charge. Moorings are not transferrable to new owners without our permission.

Boatyard Facilities

Electric: Reasonable use of electricity for hand tools is provided free of charge. Cables should be disconnected and stowed on your vessel when you are not on board. No adaptors to be used.

Water: Provided free of charge. A ½ inch tap fitting will be required for your hose.

Recycling and Waste Disposal: We have a tank for old oil, and bins for metal recycling/glass together with a general waste bin.

Toilets: We have ladies and gents toilets.

Length overall, where applicable, is rounded up to the nearest foot.

Bills for storage ashore and pontoon fees are normally raised quarterly in advance.

*Overnight on trailer package is not available for catamarans.

We do not undertake boat repairs but can put you in touch with local tradesman.
